Subject: Establishment of School Environment Clubs in All Schools in the Republic of South Sudan

In accordance with the powers conferred upon me under Article 114 (1) of the Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan, 2011, (Amended 2016), and in conformity with Section 34 read together with Section 6 (a) and (b) and Section 7 (d) and (e) of The General Education Act, 2012, I, Deng Deng Hoc Yai, Minister of General Education and Instruction, Republic of South Sudan, do hereby issue this Ministerial Order No. 25/2017 for the establishment of School Environment Clubs in All Schools in the Republic of South Sudan with effect from the date of the signing of this Ministerial Order.

Aim of the School Environment Clubs:

The aim of the School Environment Clubs is to develop environmentally responsible citizens.

Objectives of the School Environment Clubs:

The School Environment Clubs shall:

1. Promote environmental awareness;
2. Encourage learners to protect the environment; and
3. Conduct outreach environmental activities in the local communities.

The Undersecretary of Ministry of General Education and Instruction and the State Ministers of Education are hereby directed to ensure implementation of this Ministerial Order.
