Ministerial Order No. 27/2017

Subject: Ministerial Order on Licensing of Teachers in the Republic of South Sudan

In accordance with the powers conferred upon me under Article 114 (1) of **The Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan, 2011, (Amended 2016),** and in conformity with Section 22 (ii) and (iv) and Section 34 of the General Education Act, 2012, I, Deng Deng Hoc Yai, Minister of General Education and Instruction, Republic of South Sudan, do hereby issue this Ministerial Order No.27/2017 as follows:

- 1. All qualified teachers who meet the minimum quality standards shall apply for a teaching license with the National Ministry of General Education and Instruction as per Section 22 (i) from (1) to (4) of the General Education Act, 2012;
- 2. The National Ministry of General Education and Instruction will issue a license to a teacher in accordance with Section 22 (i) from 1 to 4 of the General Education Act, 2012 as follows:
 - a) Teaching license for pre-school teachers;
 - b) Teaching license for primary teachers;
 - c) Teaching license for secondary teachers; and
 - d) Teaching license for adult education teachers.
- 3. The licensing of teachers shall start with effect from 1st February 2018 and shall be completed not later than 30th July 2018; and
- 4. The Ministry of General Education and Instruction will publish the regulations related to licensing of teachers by 1st of February 2018.

The Undersecretary of Ministry of General Education and Instruction and the Director General of Quality Assurances and Standards and the Director General of Basic and Secondary Education, Ministry of General Education and Instruction are hereby directed to implement this Ministerial Order.
