PRESS STATEMENT ON RELEASE ON 2024 PRIMARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION RESULTS

Members of the press, Ladies and Gentleman,

I am delighted to inform the nation that the South Sudan National Examinations Council has finished processing of the 2024 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE) examination results. The Examinations were written between 18th November 2024 and 22nd November 2024.

A total of 79,010 candidates (43,266 males, 35,744 females) registered for the examinations. However, only 77,264 candidates (42,257 males, 35,007 females) attempted the examinations. The rest were reported absence. The examinations were administered all over the country in 1,814 schools, which were clustered into 522 examination centres.

In terms of performance, out of the 77,264 candidates (42,257 males, 35,007 females) that attempted the exams 73,326 candidates (40,427 males, 32,899 females) passed the exams, which represent an overall pass rate of 94.9%, a weighed score of 73.1 percentage performance index. The breakdown of performance is as indicated below:

- a) 450 500 Marks (13 candidates). The highest score is 453 Marks
- b) 400 449 Marks (24,319 candidates).
- c) 300- 399 Marks (42,368 candidates)
- d) 250 299 Marks (6,626 candidates)
- e) 000 249 Marks (3,878 candidates have failed the exams)

Furthermore, subject performance analysis indicates that Mathematics and Islamic Religious Education (IRE) are relatively underperformed subjects in the 2024 (CPE) exams while Science and Christian Religious Education (CRE) are the most improved subjects. Table below is referred:
