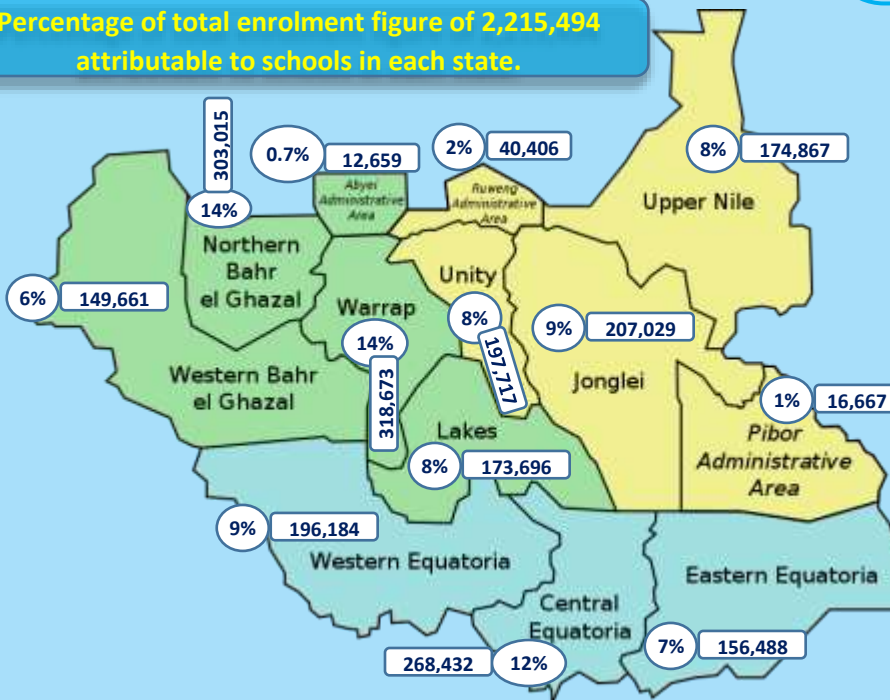


DRAFT MAIN FACT SHEET: 2023 ANNUAL EDUCATION CENSUS.



- 1** **2,215,494** enrolled in pre-primary, primary, Secondary Schools and AES
- 82% of those enrolled are in primary schools.
 - 47% of those enrolled are girls.
 - 12% annual increase in 2023 from total enrolment of 1,974, 667 in 2021.
 - 78,631 enrolled in AES (50% are female)
- 2** **17%** of the visited pre-primary, primary, AES and Secondary Schools (**7,737**) were non-operational (**1,281**)
- 52% of reached TTIs / CECs (**29**) were non-operational.
 - 40% of reached TVET schools (**30**) are non-operational.

- 3** **30%** of the enrolled were **NOT** in attendance at the day of visit to schools.
- 4** **42%** of schools had selected accessibility features for learners with disabilities.

- 5** There are **49,750** teachers in pre-primary, primary and secondary schools across the country.
- **46 : 1** is average pupil to teacher ratio
 - **76 : 1** is average pupil to qualified teacher ratio
 - Of the total teachers **20%** were female teachers.
 - **30%** of the total teachers were **NOT** in attendance at the day of visit.
- 6** There are **1,292** students (30% are female) enrolled in Teacher Training Institutes / County Education Centres
- 30% of those enrolled are female students.
 - 585 students enrolled in in-service programmes (27% are female).
 - 619 students enrolled in pre-service certificate programmes (33% are female).
 - 88 in pre-service diploma programmes (22% are female).
- 7** There were **2,426** students enrolled in both formal and informal TVET courses
- 1,052 enrolled in formal TVET courses (56% are female).
 - 1,374 enrolled in informal TVET courses (46% are female).
 - Popular informal TVET courses are in construction and tailoring while Technical Secondary School is popular in formal TVET courses.
