INTRODUCTORY NOTE PRELIMINARY 2008 SUMMARY REPORT

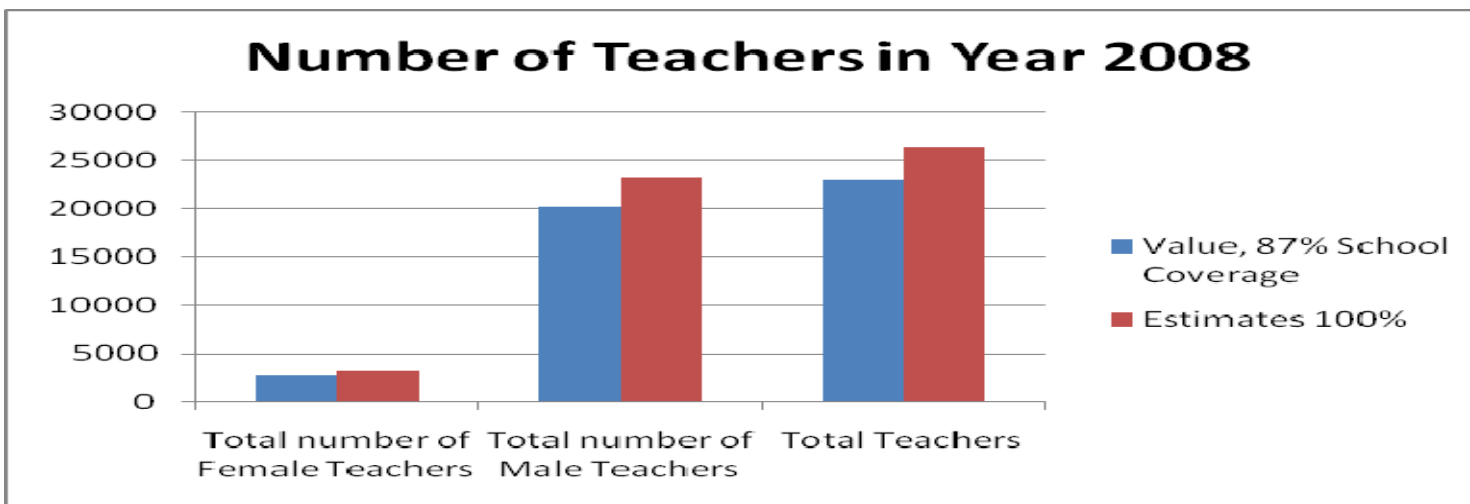
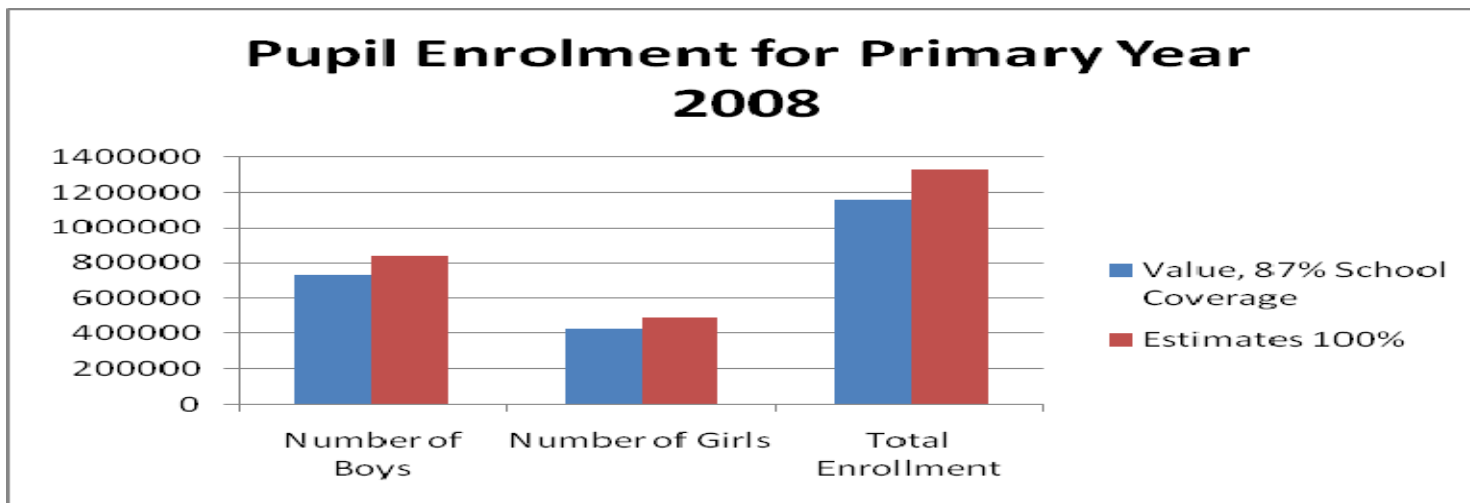
This is the Preliminary Summary Report 2008 for Southern Sudan. This covers all known Primary Schools, Alternative Education System, Secondary Schools and Higher Education Institutes whose data were collected and compiled during the period between May 2008 to January 2009. This is the first time that EMIS is able to produce report on all type of learning institutions in South Sudan. Under the Primary Schools and Alternative Education System report has also projected the 100% values for number of schools, students and teachers. Overall coverage rate is as follows:

- 1- Primary Schools (87%) includes missing of two counties in Warrap State
- 2- Alternative Schools System 52% where Some States fail to collect data because of Teacher Strikes
- 3- Secondary Schools 98%
- 4- Higher Education (Teacher Colleges, Vocational Institutes, Universities) 95%

3. Make an estimate of State Enrollment and State Teachers based upon the techniques used above;
4. Verify any values that it can, based upon the Teacher Headcount exercise;
5. Convey any updates and information to Planning and Budgeting, MoEST by April 30, 2009.

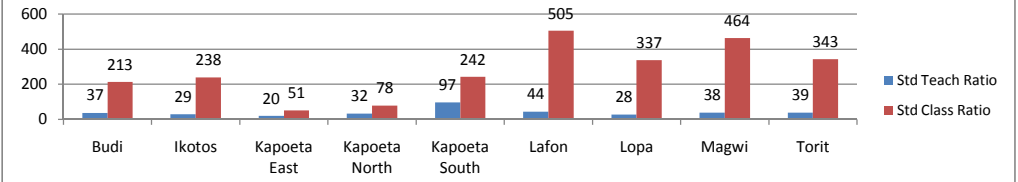
1.12 Number of Primary Schools by Pupils, Grades, Teachers, Classrooms and Counties (Year 2008)



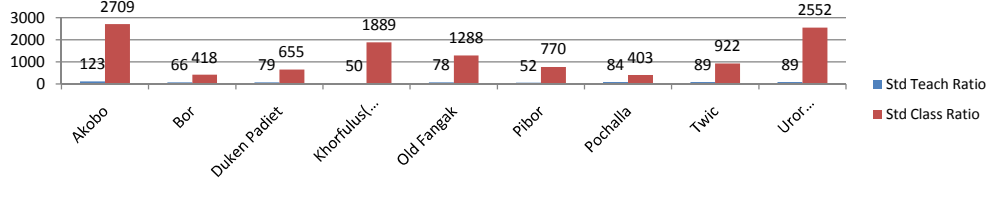
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Central Equatoria State



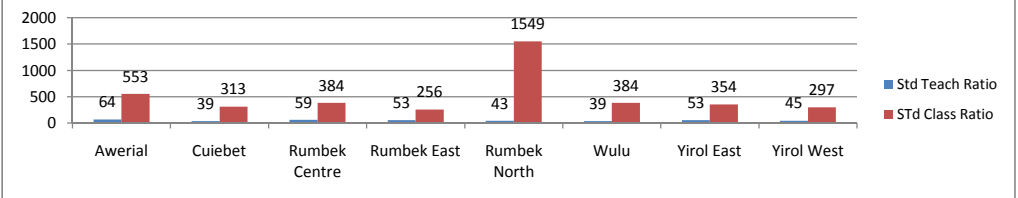
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Eastern Equatoria State



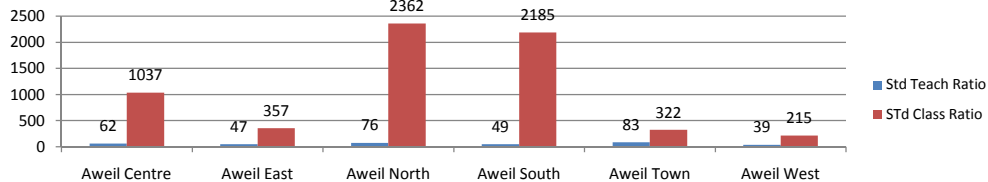
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Jonglei State



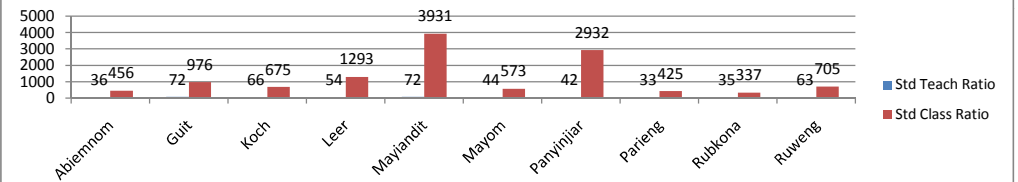
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Lakes State



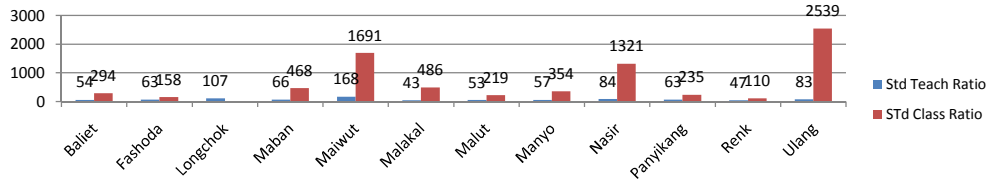
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Northern Bahr El Ghazal State



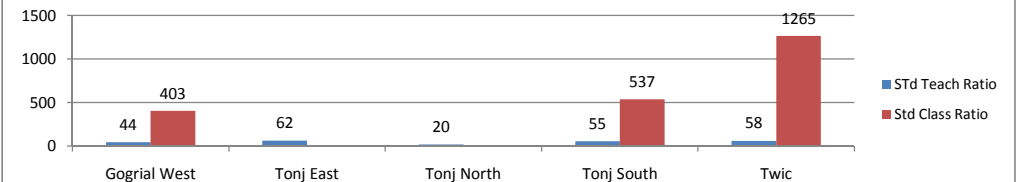
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Unity State



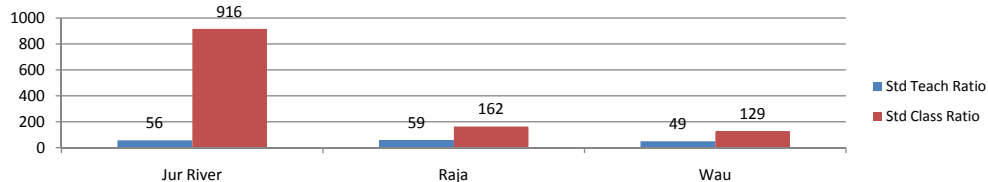
Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Upper Nile State

Student Teacher & Classroom Ratio by Counties in Western Equatoria State

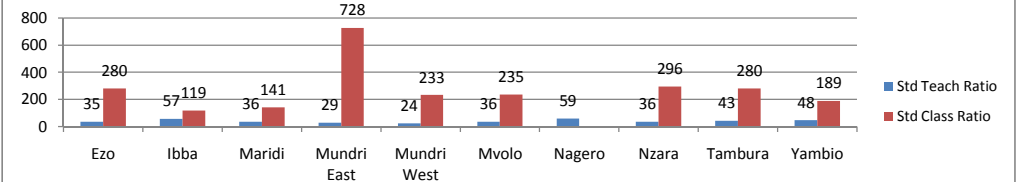
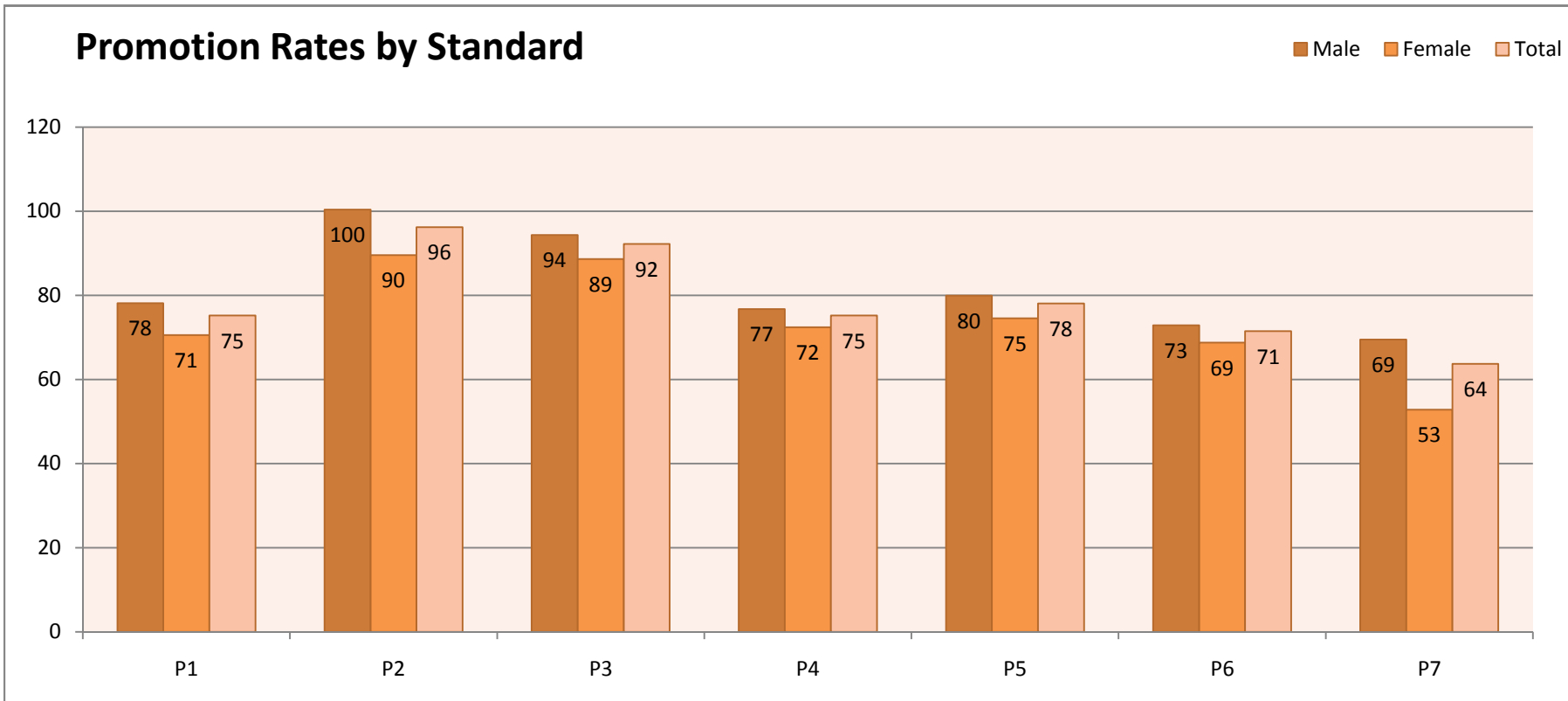

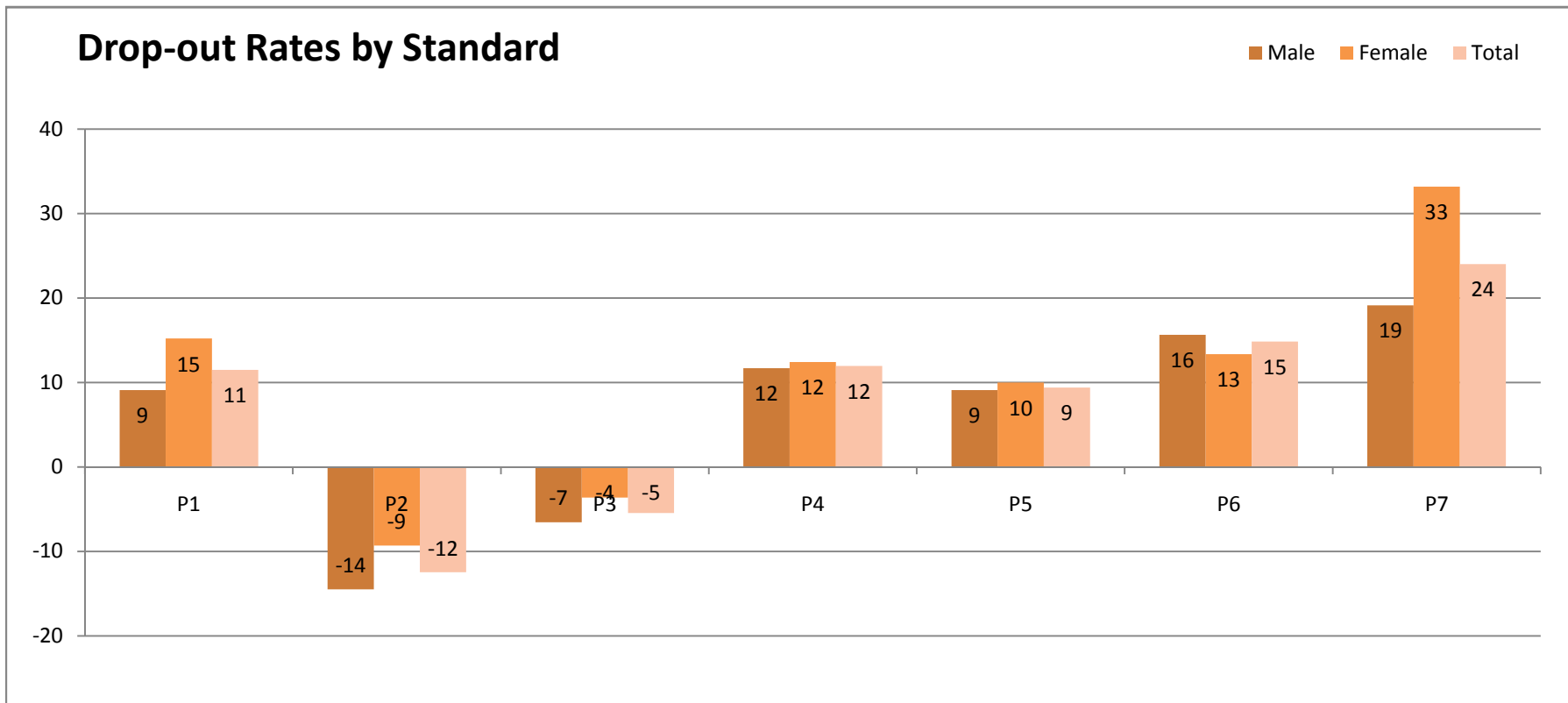

Total Coverage for AES Schools by State

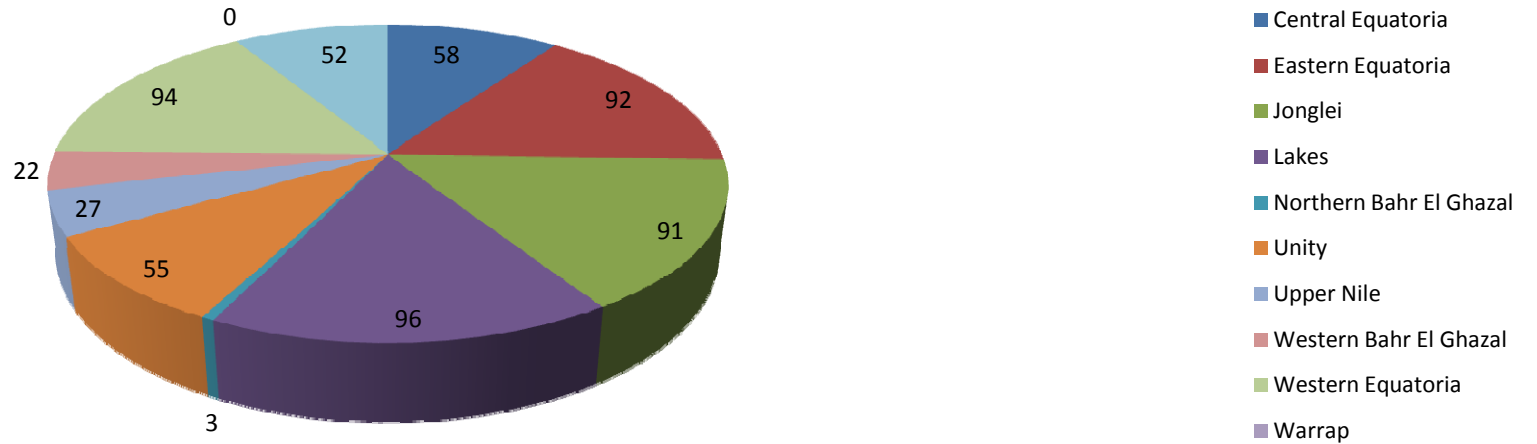

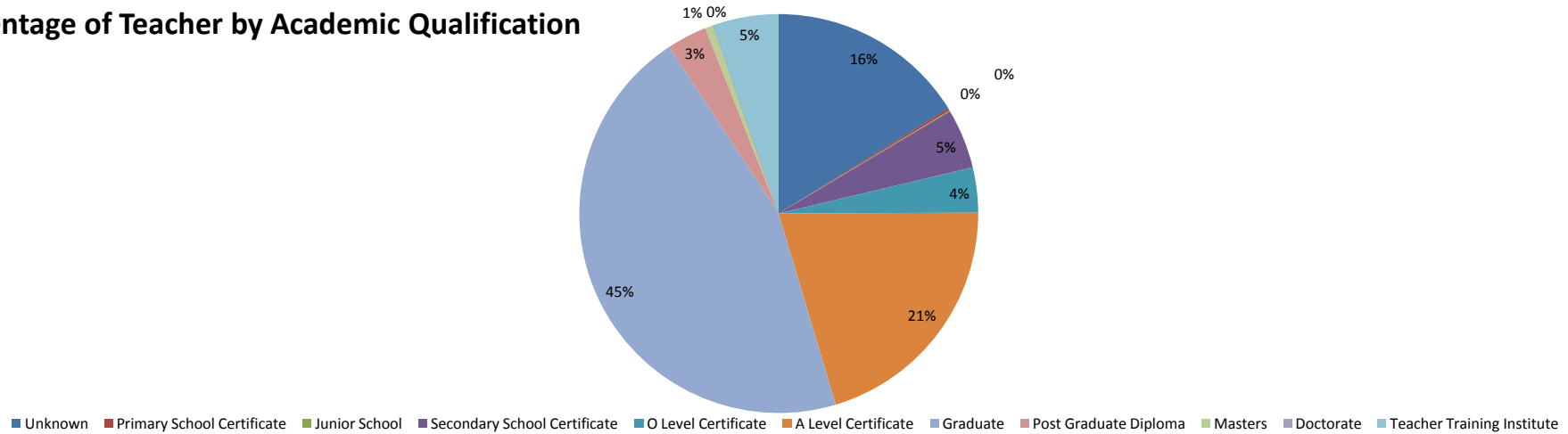
